

Dear Students and Parents:

Running Start is a Concurrent Enrollment Partnership between participating high schools and White Mountains Community College (WMCC) for 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students. Faculty and administrators at both the high school and WMCC work together to align curriculum, satisfying both high school and college academic requirements. Students have the opportunity earn credit toward high school graduation while earning college credit at WMCC at the same time. Running Start courses are taught by qualified high school faculty during the regular school day.

Running Start registration information:

All CCSNH colleges are excited to introduce a new online registration program called **DualEnroll**. This new program will allow all Running Start students to register and pay through this online program. **Your student's teacher has given your student the instructions for the registration process.**

This is a terrific opportunity for students to get a “running start” into college, saving time and money and an opportunity for students who are undecided about college to try a course. It is a goal of Running Start at WMCC to assist in creating such opportunities for students, with the hope of encouraging students to further explore post-secondary education.

College credit is earned through WMCC. Transfer credit is generally accepted among accredited schools; however, the acceptance of transfer credit is at the discretion of the institution being asked to accept it. Students having a specific school or program in mind may wish to contact the school or program about transfer credit prior to registering.
